

Nock and Belote Reelected at 80th Annual Meeting

A&N Electric Cooperative members reelected two of their peers to continue serving on the cooperative's Board of Directors during its 80th Annual Meeting held on Aug. 27.

More than 2,100 cooperative members participated in this year's election of directors through designated proxy.

- In District 1, Robert L. Nock was reelected. This district covers the northern areas of Accomack County from Parksley's northern border to the Virginia/Maryland state line and includes Tangier and Smith islands.
- In District 2, James N. "Jim" Belote III was reelected. This district covers the areas of Accomack County from Melfa's northern border to the northern border of Parksley.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the cooperative held its annual meeting at the cooperative's Tasley headquarters, with attendance limits set for health and safety.

In addition to the election of directors, the cooperative provided its members reports on its end-of-year financial status, updates on how it has handled the public health crisis, and what's ahead for the future of the co-op.

Addison Nottingham, chairman of A&N Electric Cooperative's board, highlighted the proactive steps the cooperative took to prepare for evolving COVID-19 challenges.

"Electric co-ops have a strong track record of preparing for a variety of emergencies," he said. "All while maintaining our commitment to our members."

Nottingham also pointed out the cooperative recently achieved the two-year mark of no lost-time accidents. At the time of the meeting the cooperative had gone 758 days since the most recent lost-time accident. That equates to over 280,000 man-hours worked safely.

"I am extremely proud of the

employees here for maintaining no lost time on the job for two consecutive years," Nottingham said. "This is a direct result of the unwavering commitment our employees have made."

Nottingham also reminded members that the board recently voted to retire \$2.5 million in capital credits to the membership. The cooperative typically returns capital credits to its members in August, but the board elected to expedite patronage capital to June, to help members dealing with the state of emergency.

The cooperative has retired \$29 million in capital credits to the membership since 1981.

A&N Electric Cooperative CEO Butch Williamson highlighted initiatives, which will boost value-added services offered by the cooperative.

The cooperative recently established a GenerLink transfer switch pilot program, which gives participating co-op members a safe and convenient option for connecting a portable generator to their home.

Williamson also addressed the cooperative's advanced metering infrastructure system. System deployment was completed earlier in the year. The AMI system will allow co-op members access to daily use through the cooperative's SmartHub app.

"This is empowering you (the member) to make better and quicker

decisions based on your situation," Williamson said.

Williamson was happy to announce that A&N Electric Cooperative, along with its contractor Asplundh, was awarded the certification of Tree Line USA through the Arbor Day Foundation. The program recognizes public and private utilities for pursuing practices that protect and enhance America's trees. Tree Line USA promotes the dual goals of delivering safe and reliable electricity while maintaining healthy community forests.

"We are very proud to have achieved this designation," Williamson said.

In 2019, cooperative employees formed a nonprofit organization, Lighting the Way, to help with local community needs. Nottingham applauded the work the organization has done so far with over 100 volunteer

hours logged and over \$1,500 raised by the organization and donated to local causes in its first year.

Nottingham also reported on some of the work that Members Helping Members has been doing in the local community. This year the community nonprofit distributed over \$52,000 to assist members in paying their electric service bills. That funding helped 275 local families.

Williamson added that Members Helping Members has been a critical lifeline for many during the pandemic and urged co-op members to consider contributing through small monthly donations.

Immediately following the annual meeting, the board held officer elections, reelecting Nottingham as its chairman, Christopher D. Bott as its vice chairman and Nock as the board's secretary-treasurer.

Essay Contests Open for Youth Tour and VICE Conference

The annual essay contests to determine A&N Electric Cooperative's Youth Tour and VICE Conference participants begins this month. The contests for each trip will be separated this year. A student can submit an essay for each, but can only be chosen for one trip if they meet the individual qualifications.

YOUTH TOUR

Each year the cooperative sponsors local students to attend the annual Electric Cooperative Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. The students toured Capitol Hill and also visited historical and cultural sites around the nation's capital, including the African American History Museum, Arlington National Cemetery and the Pentagon. Other activities included an evening cruise on the Potomac River and a theatrical performance at the Kennedy Center.

The Youth Tour Essay Contest is open to all high school and homeschool juniors living within the cooperative's service territory.

The student who submits the top essay from each local high school will be eligible to attend Youth Tour in June 2021. Students can select between one of two essay topics: "Electricity's Importance to the Eastern Shore" or "What Would Life Be Like Without Access to Electricity?"

Due to COVID-19, essays can be submitted directly to the cooperative by logging onto anec.com and selecting "Youth Tour" under the "Community" tab.

- Complete and Submit the Youth Tour Application Form before Dec. 4
- Completed essay submitted prior to the Dec. 4 deadline
- Live within the cooperative's service territory

VICE CONFERENCE

Each spring, the Virginia Cooperative Council sponsors an Institute on Cooperative Education, a youth leadership conference for up to 64 Virginia high

school students. Local high school and homeschool students from A&N Electric Cooperative's service area are eligible to attend.

The objective of the conference is to educate youth about the unique cooperative form of business. The top performers during the conference have the opportunity to receive up to \$2,000 in education scholarships.

VICE Conference Qualifications

- VICE attendees must be 16-19 years old as of July 1, 2021
- Complete and submit the VICE Conference Application Form before Dec. 4
- Completed essay submitted prior to the Dec. 4 deadline
- Live within the cooperative's service territory

This year the cooperative will select the top two essays submitted to join students who qualified last year to attend the conference, but were unable to due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The VICE conference takes place in spring of 2021. The essay topic for the VICE Conference contest is "What are the Benefits of the Cooperative Model of Business to the Eastern Shore?"

Due to COVID-19, essays can be submitted directly to the cooperative by logging onto anec.com and selecting "VICE Conference" under the "Community" tab.

Both conferences are at no cost to students who are selected. The cooperative also provides transportation to both events.

Power On – October is Co-op Month

As an electric cooperative, our top priority is to provide safe, reliable, affordable energy to you, the co-op members we serve. Because we are a co-op, our mission is to enhance the lives of our members and serve the long-term interests of our local community. This mission has never been more critical than in recent months. One of the seven principles that guides all co-ops is Concern for Community. This principle is essential to A&N Electric Cooperative, and it sets us apart from other electric utilities.

October is National Co-op Month,

and electric cooperatives across the country are highlighting the many ways we “Power On.” Keeping this theme in mind, the cooperative recognizes the essential role it plays in serving a special community like ours.

Who would have fathomed in March, that the COVID-19 virus would amount to a test of our community and our nation? The changing circumstances due to the pandemic have created both challenges and opportunities. Over the past several months, we’ve all been challenged to operate differently, and A&N Electric Cooperative has stepped

up to help our members and strengthen the safety net for our more vulnerable neighbors.

As an essential service, and to ensure reliability of your power supply, we modified our operations to safeguard business continuity. In the office, we limited and modified meetings and gatherings to allow for safe separation. We also adjusted our walk-in office availability and in-person service calls to ensure the health and safety of our employees and our valued members. In addition, we held an abbreviated Annual Membership Meeting and broadcast it live on local radio. For the health and safety of everyone, we feel these measures were the prudent course of action for the times.

For our members impacted by COVID-19 who needed help with their electric bills, we waived late fees and worked with those hardest hit to make special payment arrangements. We also offered payment assistance through our Members Helping Members program, a fund made possible through your kind donations.

We’ve seen other local businesses rising to meet similar challenges during this time, because that’s what communities do. While the challenges caused by COVID-19 have been daunting, it’s incredible to see how everyone is pulling together.

In 1940, A&N Electric Cooperative was built by the community to serve the community, and that’s what we’ll continue to do — Power On.

Cooperative Returns to Non-Summer Rates on Oct. 1

Just a reminder that the cooperative's non-summer rates go into effect on Oct. 1 and will run through the end of May 2021. These rates are lower compared to the summer rates co-op members experience beginning in June and running through September.

Summer electricity use drives up the wholesale cost of electricity. Recently for A&N Electric Cooperative, the highest peak demands for electricity during the summer have helped determine the cost of electricity year-round. Cooperative members pay more for the electricity they use in the four summer months (June through September), while a lower rate has been established in the eight non-summer months (October through May).

Energy Efficiency Tip of the Month

The average household owns 24 electronic products, which account for roughly 12% of home energy use. When shopping for electronics, consider purchasing Energy Star-certified products, which can be 70% more efficient than conventional models.

GenerLink Pilot Program Still Open to Co-op Members

There are still openings available for A&N Electric Cooperative's GenerLink transfer-switch pilot program for members who are interested in a safe and easy portable generator connection.

The cooperative's goal is to provide safe, reliable service to our members and to the communities we serve. While the cooperative is committed to maintaining a high level of service reliability, outages are unavoidable.

A generator can be a wonderful tool during an outage, but it can also be extremely dangerous. If used incorrectly, a generator can cause serious harm, property damage or even death.

To aid members in safely connecting a portable generator to their home's electrical system, the cooperative established a GenerLink emergency transfer switch pilot.

The GenerLink is a device installed behind the electric meter and does not require rewiring of a member's electrical system. It includes an interlocking power cord for connection of a portable generator. The device detects when the generator is operating and automatically disconnects from A&N's distribution system, eliminating a dangerous backfeed.

It can be used with compatible generators listed at generlink.com.

The program is open to a limited number of co-op members.

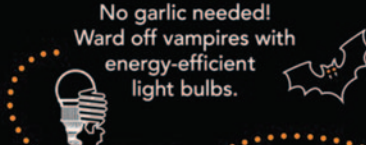
